Session I

**Tribal Enrollment
Survival Skills
March 16th & 17th**

Tribal enrollment remains the fundamental issue of tribal survival. No matter what criteria you come up with, and no matter how you legislate it, it is not about to go away. So doing it right is more important than ever. And then there is communicating it to tribal members. Tribal members need to understand the complexities of tribal enrollment, and they can only do that through informational meetings and openness by the Tribal Council, Tribal Enrollment Committee and the staff to always communicate enrollment issues honestly and with great patience. This workshop will focus on navigating the various conflicts generated in a tribal enrollment setting, including various interpretations of constitutions and enrollment ordinances, contested enrollment of individual members, and how to constructively deal with the understandable, if sometimes irrational, passion that can result from enrollment dilemmas. This session will include a presentation by the BIA on CDIBs. There will be a question and answer period to follow.

**Robert's Rules of Order
Indian Parliamentary Law
March 18th & 19th**

She also taught at Falmouth Institute for approximately 15 years and is an avid weaver. Brenda is an accomplished instructor in such subjects as; Indian Law, Ethics, Tribal Courts, Enrollment, Law for the Tribal Council, Indian Land and the Law, Law for the Board Member, and The Indian Child Welfare Act.
